

BY-LAWS OF THE BOARD

BP 8040 **Accountability, Review, and Evaluation**

In order to maintain accountability for the performance of their duties and responsibilities, the Board and the Superintendent shall provide for ongoing review and evaluation of current programs, services, and activities of the Office. The Board and the Superintendent recognize this includes regular reports to the public on qualitative and quantitative assessments.

The Board believes that the public has a right to access information and programs of the Office, except where prohibited by law or board policy. Such access will be permitted so long as programs or activities are not disrupted, and observers register and secure the consent of the Administrator prior to accessing educational programs.

The Superintendent shall establish and conduct an assessment process for schools, programs, services, and activities of the Office. This may include oral or written reports presented at regular meetings of the Board.
