**AR 0450      Comprehensive Safety Plan**

**Development and Review of School Site Safety Plan**

The County Office shall write and develop a comprehensive safety plan relevant to the needs and resources of the County Office of Education. The Superintendent or designee shall consult with local law enforcement in the writing and development of the plan.

In addition, the County Office may consult with other local agencies as appropriate, including health care and emergency services.

The County Office may delegate the responsibility for writing and developing a school safety plan to a school safety planning committee. This committee shall be composed of the following members: (Education Code 35294.1)

1. One program administrator or designee
2. One teacher who is a representative of the recognized certificated employee organization
3. One parent/guardian whose child attends the school
4. One classified employee who is a representative of the recognized classified employee organization
5. Other members, if desired

Before adopting its comprehensive school safety plan, the school safety planning committee shall hold a public meeting to allow members of the public the opportunity to express an opinion about the school safety plan.

By March 1 of each year, the safety planning committee shall evaluate, and amend as necessary, the safety plan to ensure that the plan is properly implemented. By July 30 of each year, the County Office shall report on the status of its school safety plan.

**Elements of the Safety Plan**

The safety plan shall include, but not be limited to those contents specified in Education Code § 32282.
